Parish Position Paper

The St Benedict's School Principal and Board Chair have enquired about the Parish Position Paper. The closing date for receiving questionnaire replies has therefore been extended beyond the current school holidays till 1st November, to give our two parish school communities the opportunity to respond.

This will also give time for all parishioners who are still to return their completed questionnaire to do so, by putting it in the collection basket at Mass. So far over 200 envelopes have been received, a very good response. Following the 1st of November an outside priest will audit their opening and tabulation.

At issue is the wise use of the parish assets. On the table is correspondence to the Parish Priest from the Newlands Church Committee requesting permission to begin fundraising to fix the church roof. With other parishes around the Archdiocese facing similar scenarios the Archdiocese Synod 2017 included the call to "Go, you are sent....to manage your assets wisely." So far there is no further advice from the Archdiocese.

I have therefore written the Parish Position Paper myself, asked that it be studied by each parishioner, taken care to present an open-ended questionnaire, and invited completed questionnaires to be returned in a sealed envelope marked "Confidential to the Parish Priest". This to provide every parishioner the opportunity to say what he or she thinks without undue outside influence.

After November 1st there will be a report from my desk available to both the Parish and the Archdiocese. The Position Paper and all the associated documents can be found on the Ohariu parish website.
