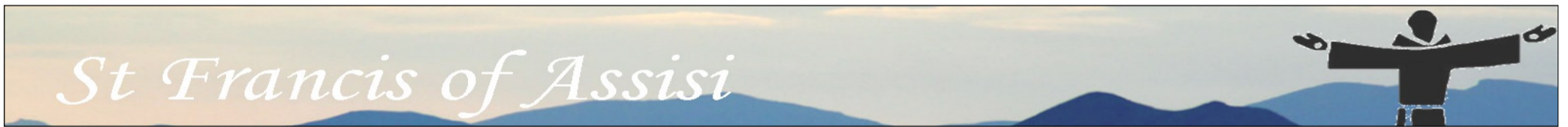
Armistice Mass
