3rd Week of Advent 15 December 2024, Year C Readings: Zephaniah 3: 14-18 Philippians 4:4-7, 8-11 Luke 3: 10-18

Joy is the theme of the third Sunday of Advent. This is reflected in this Sunday being called Guadete (Rejoice or joy) Sunday.

In the first reading from Zephaniah the prophet says "Sing - shout - be glad with all your heart."

Isaiah in his Psalm cries out "Shout aloud and sing for joy - for great is the Holy One among you."

Paul in his letter to the Philippians urges the people, "Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I say it - rejoice".

John in His Gospel portrays John the Baptist crying out to the people to prepare for the coming of the Messiah. He exhorted them to live a kind and good life and to have their hearts ready to welcome the Christ.

Although there is much sadness and suffering in our world that at times can overwhelm us, we are called to harbour joy in our hearts; a joy that can rise up within us as we anticipate the wonder, the love and hope of Christmas.

But we also have joy because as John writes in Chapter 3 of his Gospel, "God so loved the world that He sent His own beloved Son so that whoever believes in Him shall not die but have eternal life".

We rejoice in the birth of Jesus, the Christ Child but we also rejoice that through the life and death of Jesus our sins have been forgiven and we have received the wondrous gift of eternal life.

We are blessed and our hearts sing with thankfulness and joy.

May you have a joyous Christmas blessed by the indwelling of Jesus within you.



Registrations are now open. Dates are 10th to 12th January 2025. Own transport required.


Quote from Pope Francis
