A Heart that Corrodes......

An anonymous old fable told us that 'There was a man who wanted to own many rubies. So a sage said to him "if that is your wish, all the sand on the seashore would become rubies". This answer disappointed the ambitious man, for he really wanted to become rich.



Gemstones, gold and silver are only precious simply because people wish to own them. If all the gold in the world is mined, gold would lose it's monetary value. Riches can allure us to only consider our own economic wealth, losing focus on everything else that is important around us in the process. When economic gains are prioritised above the people the economy serves, unjust structures materialise that serve a select few.

Gold is a noble metal resistant to chemical change with every common treatment except putting it in a mixture of nitric and hydrochloric acids. So for the Letter of James to suggest that gold can unnaturally rot and corrode speaks volumes not of the physical corrosion of the metal, but the decay of the heart for the most important treasure of all – human life.

If our life had a purpose – it definitely isn't for some to be like fattening cattle, eating themselves to death by "their heart's content till their time of slaughter". Not to own many rubies, which if there were many, has no value in themselves. When we look after the treasure of our hearts and set our hearts on the preferential option for the poor, we bear the fruit of joy.
